



MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION FOR A NOT-FOR-PROFIT SOCIETY

The name of the Society is: “Seniors Association of St. Margaret’s Bay”

On a volunteer and non-profit basis, the objects of the Society are:

To relieve conditions associated with aging, such as loneliness and isolation, by:

- providing social, recreational, and educational programs for seniors, including virtual meetings, presentations, and assistance on use of technologies/computers;
- providing support services such as grocery shopping
- providing a list of skilled tradespeople as volunteers for home maintenance and yard care services; and
- providing referral services to appropriate agencies for assistance in areas such as housing and accommodation options.

To acquire by way of grant, gift, purchase, bequest, devise or otherwise, real and personal property and to use and apply such property to the realization of the objects of the Society.

To buy, own, hold, lease, mortgage, sell and convey such real and personal property as may be necessary or desirable in the carrying out of the objects of the Society.

Provided that:

- The Society shall not carry on any trade, industry, or business;
- All funds shall be used solely for the purposes of the Society and the promotion of its Objects.

DISSOLUTION OF THE SOCIETY

If the Society is terminated, wound up or dissolved and, after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, there remains any property whatsoever, the same shall be distributed to registered non-profit organizations in Canada having objects similar to those of the Society, on an equal basis or to qualified donees described in subsection 149.1(1) of the Income Tax Act.

The activities of the Society are to be carried in and around District 13 of the Halifax Regional Municipality. The Registered office of the Society is located at: Unit 1 - 5229 St. Margaret’s Bay Road, Upper Tantallon, Nova Scotia, B3Z 4R5.
